ROLLBAR. The code name used by U.S. Army Corporal Robert D. Dubé, born in East Greenwich, Rhode Island. As a civilian, Rollbar was a "tuner", who radically altered small cars for street racing. After enlisting, he began to maintain and improve vehicles for the reinstated G.I. Joe team -- like the Humvee he was assigned to drive. Today, like many Joes, he is a reserve member of the team. Rollbar served in Columbia during the conflict known as World War III. One of many Joes listed on World War III member assignment map first seen in AE #28.
